

Do you have:

A household plan

- Items for your Emergency Survival Kit – if you are isolated and have to look after yourself
- A Getaway Kit if you need to be evacuated

In some emergencies like a flood, you will need to evacuate and take your Getaway Kit with you. Your Getaway Kit should include:

Family documents

- Birth and marriage certificates
- Drivers' licences and passports
- Financial information (insurance policies, mortgage information, etc)
- Family photos

Personal items

- Towels, soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, toilet paper and sanitary items
- Medication, hearing aids, glasses, mobility aids for elderly or vulnerable members of your household

If you hear a Civil Defence emergency siren:

- Listen to the nearest operating local radio station for Civil Defence information
- Do not use the phone unless it is urgent
- For Police, Fire or Ambulance dial 111
