



Family Emergency Plan

Do you have a family emergency plan?

- Who will collect your young children from school/childcare?
- What should your older children do if you are not at home?
- Do you have an agreed place to leave messages (front of the refrigerator or similar)?
- Do you have a meeting and contact point if family members cannot get home (e.g. a relative or friend's home)?
- How will your family leave the house, in case of fire, or other threat?
- Where is your the nearest Civil Defence Community Emergency Centre?
- What will you do about looking after your pets?

If you hear a Civil Defence emergency siren:

- Listen to the nearest operating local radio station for Civil Defence information.
- For Police, Fire or Ambulance dial 111.
- Do not use the phone unless it is urgent.
