Casual parking: this is restricted to the hours during which the building is open - a **business hours access card** is also available for casual parking.

Casual Parking Fee 80c per hour

Permanent and Reserved Parking: access cards are available which provide 24 hour, seven day a week, access.

Parking Time Restrictions

Half hour, one hour, two hour, four hour and ten hour parking restrictions apply to all the parking meters in the city centre.

Meter Fees

Fees for parking meters range from \$1.00 per hour for busy shopping areas to 60c per hour for less frequented locations.
