Coopers Creek Working Group Update

Brief

The workshop purpose is to update the Council on progress made through the working group and facilitate members of Coopers Creek a public forum to discuss.

Council staff and representatives of licence holders for buildings at Coopers Creek are working together to better illustrate the history and tenure within the Sandy Point Domain Management Plan 2024.

Cr Tom Campbell (Deputy Mayor) is the chair of these meetings.

This Coopers Creek update was requested verbally at the Community Wellbeing Committee in September 2023, at the time that elected members endorsed the Sandy Point Domain Masterplan for public feedback.

The outcome sought is to provide the elected members with time to learn and discuss the history and tenure of the buildings at Coopers Creek within Sandy Point Domain Reserve.

This will enable the working group to continue towards developing 'options' to be presented to Council (June 2024), before inclusion in the draft Reserve Management Plan.

The decision from elected members on the 'options' will be included in the draft Sandy Point Domain Reserve Management Plan 2024, ready for public consultation this calendar year.
