Purpose and Summary

This report is to provide the Committee with an update on financial position for the eight months ended 28 February 2025.

- Total grants paid out Round 1 \$81,740.
- Total grants paid out Round 2 \$144,000.
- Total grants paid out Round 3 \$132,950.
- Unused grant returned \$21,900.
- Total funds remaining \$122,510.

Background

This fund will distribute up to \$565,000 in 2024/2025 across five funding rounds. The purpose is to provide a source of community funding to enable projects across the city.

This fund has the goal of supporting social, cultural, environmental and economic wellbeing as well as supporting the Council's vision to create "Our City with Heart – He Ngākau Aroha".

Current Year


The total funds available for the Community Wellbeing Fund is \$565,000 for the 2024/2025 Financial Year. Three funding rounds have now been completed with three more remaining.

The total funds paid out as at 28 February 2025 were \$358,690, plus three grants totalling \$21,900 were returned leaving the amount left to be allocated to applications across the next two rounds at \$122,510.

Multi-year commitments (approved during previous financial years) for the 2024/2025 Financial Year total \$108,200 and are incorporated in the funds allocated amount above.

All grant invoices have been paid in Round 1, Round 2 and Round 3. There have been two grants uplifted from the Multiyear commitments to date.

Based on the above, there remains allocation available to spend in Round 4 of this financial year on the requested applications according to the usual priorities of the Community Wellbeing Fund.



Next Year

The total funds available for the next 2025/2026 Financial Year will be determined during Annual Plan Year Two of the Long-term Plan.

There are currently \$144,800 multi-year commitments for the 2025/2026 Financial Year.

Any remaining unspent funds at the end of any given financial year are **not** rolled over into the following financial year allocation.
